


❖ Wallet Management Tutorial (Whitelist)

The "Whitelist" section in your Otet Markets account profile allows you to add new wallet addresses or remove existing ones. This feature provides a centralized view of all your saved wallet addresses, enabling you to manage them as needed.


Please note that to use the wallet address management feature, you must first enable Google Authenticator on your Otet account. You can find the steps in our account security tutorial ([link to the article](#)).

To create a Whitelist, follow these steps:

- 1.1. From the right-side menu of your dashboard, click on "Profile".
- 1.2. In the profile menu, select "Security"




1.3. On the opened page, you will see a section called "Whitelist". By clicking the button next to it, you can add a new wallet address to your account.




Please note that you are solely responsible for ensuring the accuracy of the wallet address you enter. Otet Markets will not be held liable for any errors in the wallet address.


At this step, this option will appear as follows:




2. Clicking "Add" will open a new window. Here, you'll need to enter the cryptocurrency type and blockchain network in the first row, followed by your wallet address in the second row. Please note that both fields are required. Once you've entered the information, the "Submit" button will turn green, allowing you to save the wallet address. You can also add a Destination Tag for your wallet address in the designated section.




3. Upon clicking "Submit", a new window will pop up, prompting you to enter a confirmation code. This code will be sent to the email address you provided during your Otet registration.




4. The email you receive will contain a 5-digit pin code and a confirmation button labeled "Confirm with a link". You can either manually enter the received code into the corresponding field on your dashboard (as shown in the image above), or click the green button within the email body (as shown in the image below) to complete the email verification process.




5. After entering the code and clicking "Proceed" in the window described in step 3, or by clicking the green button in the email, the process of adding your new wallet address to the Whitelist will be completed.




6. In addition to adding new wallet addresses, you can also remove old ones from the Whitelist. To do this, simply click on the trash can icon next to the wallet address you want to delete.



7. By clicking on this icon, a new window will open prompting you to enter your email verification code.



8. The email you'll receive simultaneously from Otet will contain a 5-digit PIN code and a confirmation button labeled "Confirm with a link". You can either manually enter the received code into the corresponding field on your dashboard (as shown in the image above), or click the green button within the email body (as shown in the image below) to complete the wallet deletion process.



9. After entering the code and clicking "Continue" in the window described in step 7, or by clicking the green button in the email (as shown in the image above), the old wallet address will be removed from the Whitelist.
